From the Interim Rector

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6

Dear people of God at St. John's Episcopal Church,

We are knee-deep in Lent with Holy Week and Easter just around the corner.

And during this solemn but busy season we also have three especially important parish meetings with The Rev. Canon Jessie Dodson that will help guide the Rector search process. Those will take place on three successive Thursdays, March 7, 14, and 21, following Lenten Midweek Evening Prayer, which begins at 6:30 p.m. each Thursday. I'm sure you'll read or hear about these meetings elsewhere and at several other times. But the value of your presence bears repeating.

Although I am only in my second month among you and incredibly happy to be here, I will remind you at every opportunity that I am only here for an interim period of time. And during this period, one of my responsibilities is to invite you into a process of spiritual discernment that will help you envision what type of leader you are seeking.

There are decisions which need to be made. And my prayer is that, as Christians, you will have the confidence to let Jesus Christ guide your decision on the future. A Scripture verse that has been a strength for me is the one quoted above from Proverbs 3:5-6.

The constant in our life, and our life of faith, needs to be the presence of Christ. I can't emphasize enough how far a few moments in silent prayer will go to enable us to contemplate those places we feel we may be resisting God's activity in our lives, and/or to discover an opportunity or a challenge we may feel God is inviting us to embrace or entertain.

And the best way we stay connected to God is by worshiping regularly. That is the most important experience that happens in church. It is from your gathering together each week that all ministry flows. It is here where you are fed with the word and sacrament and are sent out into the world to make the name of Christ known to others by your words and by your deeds.

The work of God, happens best, it seems, when the people hear God still speaking to them in their own place and time, in their own situation, and listen for where God is leading them and whom God is sending to lead them. The church cannot be separated from God in Jesus Christ. God's presence in our lives is the foundation of our life together.






