Dear people of God at St. John's Episcopal Church,

I am still basking in the glow of the glorious Easter festival that we celebrated together. The emotions of that day will linger in my memory for quite a while.

In the two months that I have served this parish I have not witnessed such enthusiasm. It will be hard to top the events of that entire week.

It revealed to me a few things about the people here; above all, that when we are excited about something, we work hard to make it happen.

I was impressed by:

- The "worker bees," otherwise known as the Altar Guild, who scurried about to make sure all the flowers, the decorations and all communion and liturgical elements were in their proper place for each service.
- The choir, the musicians, the acolytes, the lectors, the ushers, and all the others who had a part in the innumerable liturgies that we held over the entire week.
- The cooks who contributed to the veritable cornucopia of culinary delights that we feasted on during the Easter brunch.
- The bulletins that had to be prepared, the cleaning and moving of furniture to make sure all was ready for the people to feel welcomed.
- If I've forgotten someone or something, please know that I appreciate anything you did, however great or small.

In the readings for the Second Sunday of Easter, there are two verses which I posted above. In many ways, they inform and guide our relationship to each other as children of God.

The reading from Acts is a description of the Early Church and how they came together to continue the ministry of Jesus after he departed this Earth. One cannot ignore the fact that it was AFTER Easter that the Church grew.

So, the questions this raises in my mind is, what changes would transform St. John's into an Easter church? I saw the expressions of joy in your faces upon seeing the many people that were here, some who had not attended in a while. What can we learn from the joyous experience of Holy Week and apply it to our life together as a faith community?

I am convinced that the power of Christ's resurrection can inspire the life of this church to deepen that Easter spirit in the days and weeks ahead.

You are, after all, Easter people, created to live together in unity, to proclaim the Gospel and to carry out Christ's mission of justice, peace, and love.

Family Service Begins!


